

ABOUT PARROT SOCIETY (SINGAPORE)

Parrot Society Singapore, founded in 2022 by passionate parrot owners, is a non-profit focused on improving the welfare and care of parrots in Singapore. We've rescued and cared for numerous parrots, and shared our expertise within the community. Our main goal is to educate the public on proper parrot care through various programs, workshops, and seminars covering behaviour, diet, and health, aiming to strengthen the bond between parrot owners and their birds.

VISION:

To achieve a Singapore where parrots are no longer unethically exploited, and where they can coexist with humans peacefully.

MISSION:

To elevate the welfare standards of parrot-keeping in Singapore through education and outreach, and to provide a sustainable system through which abandoned, neglected, and mistreated parrots can be aided.

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

2024 was a challenging year for us, largely due to a lack of manpower. It was a tough position to be in, and we had to make hard decisions, like prioritising surrender cases and scaling back activities. However, these challenges provided an opportunity to refocus on what truly matters—ensuring the welfare of parrots remains our top priority. We remained committed to offering support wherever possible, while adhering to ethical rescue practices that prioritise quality care over quantity.

We took this time optimise our fostering and adoption processes, redefine volunteer roles to make them clearer, and strengthen connections with our team to better match people's skills to their roles. These efforts are already starting to pay off, and by the end of the year, we launched our newly structured organisation, setting the stage for a more efficient future.

Even with the slowdown, 2024 brought some highlights. We became an AVS Animal Welfare Group Partner, paving the way for more outreach opportunities. We continued forming partnerships with like-minded groups and vendors. And our work even caught the media's eye, with a feature on responsible pet ownership—a sign that our mission is gaining recognition.

Looking ahead, we remain hopeful for 2025. We're focused on building on our progress, inspiring more people to join us as fosterers and volunteers, and helping more parrots in need. With your support, we're confident we can continue making a meaningful impact.




WELFARE ENQUIRIES

This year, we have taken in and provided support for 8 parrots. We have also received and followed up on 8 other case reports of abuse and neglect.



One special support case was a parrot belonging to a person who has been warded in hospital in emergency. The social worker found out that the patient has a young parrot at home with nobody to take over the care of, hence contacted PSS to seek our support. We are happy to share that the patient has been discharged and has happily reunited with the parrot!



We also took a moment to recognise a few outstanding individuals whose hard work and commitment have made a meaningful impact on our mission.






YOUR SUPPORT MEANS THE WORLD TO US— AND TO THE PARROTS WE HELP
